Dear Parents / Guardians,

Attached is the booklist for your child's class in 2022/23.

The booklist highlights the books you need to purchase yourself, which we have tried to keep to a minimum. The books are available locally from Cobh School Books (located on Bishop Street) as well as from other suppliers outside of town. All other books, copies, readers and resources are provided by the school under our book-rental scheme.

The cost due for each child this year has been maintained at €90. The costs cover all the resources we supply to your child. In the interest of fairness, we would ask that all families make an effort to pay this cost. However, if there is any difficulty paying these class costs, please speak to the principal / deputy to make suitable arrangements. Families that have not paid the costs without explanation will be required to furnish all the necessary equipment, books and book rental items themselves. These items will not be available from the school shop.

The school does not ask for 'voluntary contributions' in that the class costs cover actual materials that your child uses. If the school did not provide these materials, you would have to purchase them yourself at a significantly greater cost.

The cost also covers the activities such as Zumba, tennis, drama, visiting teachers and subsidises swimming lessons for various class levels.

We are always investing significantly in school-wide programmes for our students so that the most up-to-date resources, books and information available to schools is at your child's disposal.
